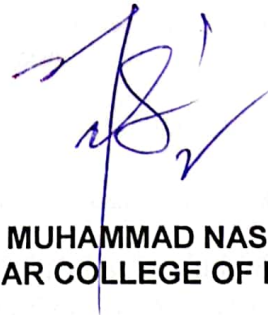

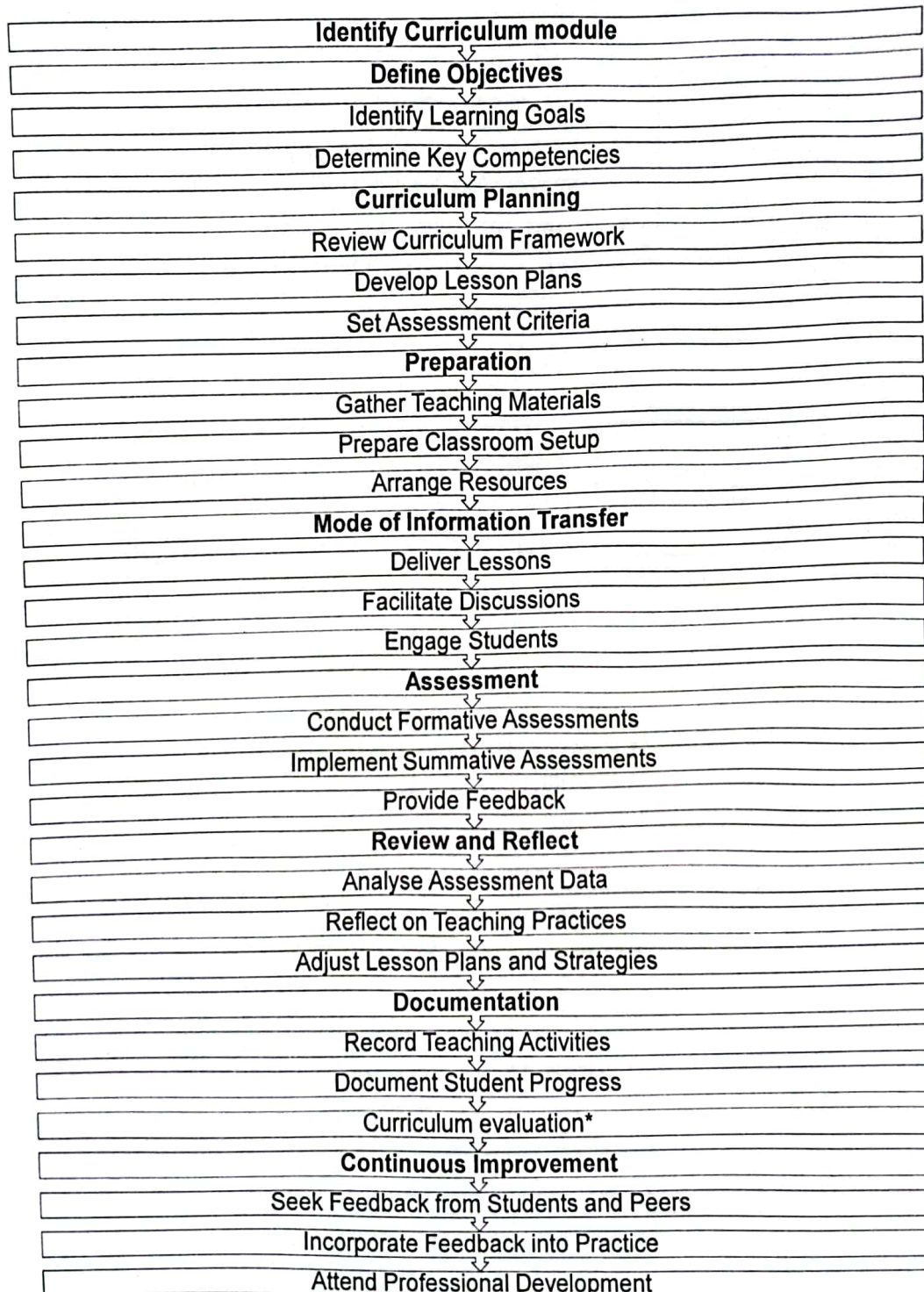
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Teaching curriculum involves several key steps to ensure it is effective, engaging, and meets educational standards. Here's a general outline of the process:

- Identify the type of module and define Objectives
- Identify Learning Outcomes: Determine what students should know, understand, and be able to do by the end of the course or unit.
- Determine Key Competencies and outline the content and skills to be covered
- Curriculum Planning according to the module selected and establish a timeline for each topic or unit.
- Design the Curriculum Framework
- Incorporate Assessment Methods which includes:
 - **Formative Assessments:** Including quizzes, observations, and discussions to gauge ongoing understanding.
 - **Summative Assessments:** Plan for end-of-unit or end-of-course assessments, such as tests, projects, or presentations.
 - **Feedback Mechanisms:** Design ways to provide constructive feedback to students.
- Review and Reflect to Ensure that the curriculum aligns with learning objectives, assessments, and standards.
- Regularly evaluate and update the curriculum based on student feedback and performance.
- Document and record all the teaching activities and student progress
- Curriculum evaluation and changes according to policy made for curriculum changes.
- Continuous improvement after feedback from student and faculty.
