Reimbursement of Publication Fees for Research

Articles - (Faculty)

Reimbursement for publication fees (APC) for research articles will be processed under the following conditions:

- Eligibility: Reimbursement is available only for articles submitted through R&D within
 months from the publication date.
- Criteria for Publication: Reimbursement applies to articles published in journals recognized by PM&DC or HEC, or indexed in Medline, PubMed, PubMed Central, Index Medicus, Scopus, or listed in Web of Science (including JCR-listed journals with impact factors or the WoS Master Journal List, including the Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI)).

3. Reimbursement Calculation:

- The reimbursement amount will be calculated based on the publication fee divided by the total number of authors. Reimbursement will be provided only for the share of the fee attributed to authors affiliated with Rahbar College of Dentistry, Lahore.
- 4. **Required Documentation**: To process reimbursement, submit the invoice, payment receipt, published paper, and verification from the Director of R&D.
- 5. **Eligibility for Claim**: Only faculty members of RCoD can claim reimbursement for their published research articles.
- 6. **Submission Deadline**: Reimbursement applications must be submitted to the R&D office within 2 months of the publication date. Late submissions will not be considered.

Student Research Authorship Incentive

Objective

By providing financial incentives, we aim to motivate students to engage in rigorous research activities, contribute to the advancement of knowledge, and prepare for successful careers in their chosen fields

Requirement

To qualify for this incentive, the article must be published in a journal recognized by HEC and must have been supervised by a faculty member of RCoD with a postgraduate qualification.

Procedure

Applications for the student research incentive must be submitted to R&D within 2 months from the date of publication. The application, endorsed by the supervising faculty member as the senior author, must include a copy of the published paper showing the student author(s)' affiliation with RCoD and proof of HEC indexing from the HJRS website.
